Kyoto University Active Geosphere Investigations for the 21st Century

27th (Saturday) August to 9th (Friday) September, 2011 at Kyoto University in Kyoto and Crefeel Koto in Shiga, Japan

This International Summer School aims to introduce participants to a new multi-disciplinary approach for the Earth sciences that emphasizes the physical and/or chemical processes that are encompassed in the "Active Geosphere". It is intended for graduate students and postdoctoral researchers who received their doctorate degrees on or after August 28, 2005. And this year, we accept participants who possess nationalities of ASEAN countries, India or Japan.
