4th KAGI21 International Summer School at ITB in Indonesia: Jul. 22-Aug. 3, 2007

I am writing to inform you of the 4th International Summer School of *Kyoto University Active Geosphere Investigations for the 21st Century COE Program - KAGI 21*, to be held from 22nd in July to 3rd in August 2007 at the Institut Teknologi Bandung in Indonesia. This school was established to foster young scientists in Asia and Oceania in cooperation with the Faculty of Earth Science and the Mineral Technology of Institut Teknologi Bandung. It is aimed at Ph.D.-course graduate students and young scientists who will lead a new multi-disciplinary approach for the Earth sciences that emphasizes the physical and/or chemical processes that are encompassed in the "Active Geosphere".

The core lectures will be given by professors of Kyoto University. In addition to the lectures, field trip, computer experiments and poster presentation by the participants will be held and we expect all participants in the summer school to present their posters.

This year, also "The 10th Kyoto University International Symposium: Active Geosphere Science" will be held at Bandung on July 26, 27 and 28. All participants in the summer school will attend the symposium as a part of the summer school program.

The tuition of this summer school is free, and travel expenses will be almost fully supported by KAGI21. We limit the number of the students to 40 (about 10 from Indonesia and 30 from other countries). If the number of applicants is greater than 40, there will be a selection based on the description on the application forms. All applicants will be notified of the results of the selection by the end of March 2007.

I hope that you will bring this course to the attention of any graduate students and colleagues in your department or institution who may be interested and that you will display the enclosed poster.
